



PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 PM today, the eye of Typhoon "HELEN" was located based on all available data at **415 km East Northeast of Basco, Batanes (21.5°N, 125.8°E)** with maximum sustained winds of up to 150 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 185 kph. It is forecast to move West Northwest at **20 kph**.
