**PRESENT WEATHER:**

At 4:00 AM today, the eye of Typhoon "DINDO" was located based on all available data at 1,160 KM East Northeast of Itbayat, Batanes (23.6°N, 132.7°E) with maximum sustained winds of 150 KPH near the center and gustiness of up to 185 KPH. It is forecast to move East Northeast at 13 KPH. Southwest Monsoon affecting the western section of Luzon.
