PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 PM today, Tropical Depression “Queenie” was estimated based on all available data at 90 KM East Southeast of Cuyo, Palawan (10.3°N, 121.6°E. It is forecast to move West Northwest at 24 KPH. Palawan, Negros Occidental, Guimaras Island, Iloilo and Antique will have rains. Mindanao, the rest of Visayas, Bicol Region and Provinces of Quezon, Mindoro, Marinduque and Romblon will experience cloudy skies with light to moderate rainshowers and thunderstorms.
