PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Storm "MARCE" was estimated based on all available data at 230 km Northwest of Dagupan City, Pangasinan (16.8°N, 118.3°E) with maximum winds of 75 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 95 kph. It is forecast to move North at 11 kph.
