PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 AM today, the eye of Typhoon "Jenny" was located based on all available data at 645 km East Northeast of Itbayat, Batanes (22.1°N, 127.9°E), with maximum sustained winds of 160 KPH near the center and gustiness of up to 195 KPH. It is forecast to move west northwest at 15 KPH. Southwest monsoon affecting Southern Luzon and Visayas.
