PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 PM today, the eye of Typhoon "Jenny" was located based on all available data at 530 km East Northeast of Itbayat, Batanes (22.7°N, 126.5°E), with maximum sustained winds of 185 KPH near the center and gustiness of up to 220 KPH. It is forecast to move west northwest at 15 KPH. Southwest monsoon affecting Southern Luzon and Visayas.
