At 4:00 PM today, the eye of Typhoon "HELEN" was located based on all available data at 320 km Northeast of Basco, Batanes (22.6°N, 124.0°E) with maximum sustained winds of up to 160 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 195 kph. It is forecast to move West Northwest at 20 kph.
