PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 AM today, Tropical Depression "SENIANG" was estimated based on all available data at 340 km East of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (7.9°N, 129.4°E). Tail-end of a cold front affecting Bicol Region. Northeast Monsoon affecting Northern and Central Luzon.

ZAMBOANGA SIBUGAY - particularly Sibuguey, Taguite, Tumaga, Tigbao, Digsa, Sanito, Bakalan and Kabasalan.

WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries particularly in:
	 MAGUINDANAO – particularly Mindanao, Allah, Buluan, Dalika, Lower M'Lang, Y' Lang, and Nituan.
