At 4:00 AM today, Tropical Depression "SENIANG" was estimated based on all available data at 340 km East of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (7.9°N, 129.4°E). Tailend of a cold front affecting Bicol Region. Northeast Monsoon affecting Northern and Central Luzon.
