#### PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 PM today, Tropical Depression "SENIANG" was estimated based on all available data at 150 km East of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (8.2°N, 127.7°E) with maximum sustained winds of 55 KPH near the center. It is forecast to move west northwest at 13 KPH. Northeast Monsoon affecting Northern and Central Luzon.
