ZAMBOANGA DEL NORTE particularly Paro-Dapitan, Dipolog, Dikaya, Golid Duwait, Sindangan, Ingin (Maras), Palandoc, Bucas, Pataug Quipit, Siocon, Piacan, Anungan, Pangamiran and Sibuco.

SARANGANI particularly Kalaong, Buayan-Malungan, Little-Lun, Big-Lun and Gian. SOUTH COTABATO particularly Siquil, Makar and Banaga.

AGUSAN DEL NORTE particularly Lake Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos, and Cabadbaran SURIGAO DEL NORTE particularly Surigao and Magallanes. SURIGAO DEL SUR particularly Cantillan, Toracan, Tandag, Tago, Hubo-Oteiza, Hinatuan, and Bislig
