At 4:00 AM today, the eye of Typhoon "Jenny" was located based on all available data at **390 km Northeast of Itbayat, Batanes (23.2°N, 124.6°E)**. It is forecasted to move West Northwest at **19 kph**. Southwest monsoon affecting **Central** and Southern Luzon and **Western** Visayas.
