At **3:00 PM** today, the **Low Pressure Area (Formerly "USMAN")** was estimated based on all available data at **60 km** East of **Romblon, Romblon (12.6 N, 122.8 E)**. **Tail-end of a cold front affecting Southern Luzon and Eastern Visayas**. Northeast Monsoon affecting Northern and Central Luzon.
