AT 4:00 AM TODAY, THE LOW PRESSURE AREA (LPA) WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 370 KM EAST OF BORONGAN, EASTERN SAMAR (11.2°N, 128.8°E) EMBEDDED ALONG INTERTROPICAL CONVERGENCE ZONE (ITCZ) AFFECTING VISAYAS AND MINDANAO.
