Lucia, Lugan Malaybalay, Maapon, Bucal (Lalangan), Lakayat, Tignoan, Agos, Anibawan (Polilio Island), and Upper Kilbay – Catabangan LAGUNA particularly Pagsanjan, Pila-Sta. Cruz, San Juan, and San Cristobal CAVITE particularly Laboc (Balsahan), Cañas, Ilang-Ilang, and Imus RIZAL particularly Upper Marikina and Kaliwa BATANGAS particularly Lian, Banabang-Molino, Pansipit, Kapumpong, Rosario-Lobo, Upper Bolbok (Lawaya)

People living near the mountain slopes and in low-lying area of the above-mentioned river systems and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils concerned are still advised to take precautionary measures.
