At **3:00 AM** today, the Low Pressure Area (Formerly "USMAN") was estimated based on all available data at **240 km NorthWest of Zamboanga City, Zamboanga del Sur (8.3 N, 120.4 E)**. Tail-end of a cold front affecting Southern Luzon. Northeast Monsoon affecting Northern and Central Luzon.

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p>Rivers and Tributaries in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • EASTERN SAMAR - particularly in Oras, Dolores, Ulot, Taft, Borongan, Suribao, Llorento, Balangiga And Sulat. • NORTHERN SAMAR - particularly in Catarman, Bugko, Pambukhan, Catubig, Palapag, Maou and Gamay. • LEYTE - particularly in Sangputan, Palo, Salano (Quilot), Daguitan Marabang, Cadacan, Bongquirogon, Salug, Pagbanagaran, Pagsangahan and Binahaan. • SAMAR - particularly in Basey, Silaga, Calbiga and Jibatan. • BILIRAN - all rivers and its tributaries.
