At 4:00 AM today, the Tropical Storm “Seniang” was estimated based on all available data including Cebu Doppler Radar at 35 KM Southeast of Mactan, Cebu (9.9°N, 123.7°E) with maximum sustained wind of 65 KPH near the center and gustiness of up to 80 KPH. It is forecast to move west northwest at 11 KPH
