At 4:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 330 km South Southwest of Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (7.9°N, 117.7°E). Tail end of a cold front affecting the Eastern section of Northern and Central Luzon.
