**AT 4:00 PM TODAY, THE CENTER OF TROPICAL DEPRESSION "CARINA" WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 290 KM NORTHEAST OF VIRAC, CATANDUANES (15.3°N, 126.2°E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 65 KPH NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 80 KPH. IT IS FORECAST TO MOVE NORTHWEST AT 18 KPH.**
