PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 PM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 630 KM East of Guiuan, Eastern Samar (10.7N, 131.5E). Southwest Monsoon affecting extreme Northern Luzon. Typhoon JEBI at 3:00 PM Location: 2,775 KM East of Northern Luzon (17.8N, 147.9E) (Outside Par), Maximum Sustained Winds: 160 KM/H, Gustiness: Up to 195 KM/H, Movement: West at 20 KM/H.

At 3:00 PM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at **415 KM East of Guiuan, Eastern Samar (10.5N, 129.5E)**. Southwest Monsoon affecting extreme Northern Luzon. **Typhoon JEBI at 3:00 AM Location: 2,500 KM East of Northern Luzon (17.8N, 145.3E) (Outside Par), Maximum Sustained Winds: 180 KM/H, Gustiness: Up to 220 KM/H**, Movement: West at 20 KM/H.
