**At 4:00 AM today, the Tropical Storm "SENIANG" was estimated based on all available data at 150 KM Southwest of Cuyo, Palawan (9.7°N, 120.1°E) with maximum sustained winds of 65 KPH near the center and gustiness of up to 80 KPH. It is forecast to move west southwest at 13 KPH**
