No. 06 (Final) for Region II (Cagayan Valley)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light rains and isolated thunderstorm
WATERCOURSES NO LONGER TO BE AFFECTED	 Rivers and Tributaries in: ISABELA particularly Dikatayan, Dinilican and Palananpinacanauan CAGAYAN particularly Linao, Lower Abulug, Lower Pamplona, Cabicungan, Aunugay, Baua, Palawaig and Taboan

No. 4 (Final) for Region III (Central Luzon)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light rains and isolated thunderstorm
WATERCOURSES	Rivers and Tributaries in:
NO LONGER TO	BATAAN particularly Balanga and Moron
BE AFFECTED	AURORA particularly in Casiguran, Aguang and Lower Umiray

No. 02 for Region 11 (Davao Region)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rainshowers and thunderstorm
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	 Rivers and Tributaries in: Davao Del Norte particularly Tagum-Libuganon, Tuganay, Saug and Lasang. Dava Oriental particularly Catul, Dapras, Bangaga Mahaneb, Manurigo, Caraga, Casaunan, Quinonoan, Bugnan-Mayo, Bitanayan and Sumlog. Compostela Valley particularly Matibo and Hijo. Davao Del Sur particularly Davao, Talomo, Lipadas, Tagulaya Sibulan, Digos and Padada Mainit.

No.02 for Region 13 (Caraga)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light rains with isolated thunderstorms
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	 Rivers and Tributaries in: Dinagat Islands particularly Malinao Inlet and Gaas Lulet. Agusan Del sur particularly Ojot,Wawa, Libang,Maosam Kasilan,Gibong,adgaon,Sinulao,Kayonan and Andanan. Surigao del Norte particularly Surigao and Magallanes Agusan del Norte particularly Lake Mainit, Tubay, Asiga, Agusan,Llnugos and Cabadbaran. Surigao Del Sur particularly Cantillan, Toracan, Tandag, Tago,Hubo-Oteinza,Hinatuan and Bislig.

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low lying areas of the above mentioned river systems and the LDRRMCs concerned are still advised to be alert for possible flashfloods and landslides and to take the necessary precautionary measures.
