PRESENT WEATHER

At 3:00 PM today, the low pressure area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 850 KM East of Surigao City, Surigao del Norte (9.8 N, 133.2E). Tail-end of a cold front affecting Bicol Region and Eastern Visayas. Northeast monsoon affecting Northern and Central Luzon.

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Dinagat Islands particularly Malinao Inlet and Gaas Lulet.• Agusan del Sur particularly Ojot, Wawa, Libang, Maosam, Kasilan, Gibong, Adgaoan, Sinulao, Kayonan and Andanan.• Surigao del Norte particularly Surigao and Magallanes.• Agusan del Norte particularly Lake-Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos and Cabadbaran.• Surigao del Sur particularly Cantillan, Toracan, Tandag, Tago, Hubo-Oteiza, Hinatuan and Bislig.
