No. 04 for Region II (CAGAYAN VALLEY)

No. 03 for Region III (CENTRAL LUZON)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains and isolated thunderstorms.
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • AURORA particularly Casiguran, Aguang and Lower Umiray.

No. 07 for Region 5 (Bicol Region)

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CAMARINES NORTE particularly Labo and Daet Basud. • CAMARINES SUR particularly Lower Kilbay, Catabangan, Ragay, Tinalmud, Tambang and Lagonoy. • CATANDUANES particularly Cabuyan, Bato and Pajo. • MASBATE particularly Lanang, Mapayawan, Mandaong, Asid, Malbag, Guiom, Nainday, Daraga, Nauco (Aguada) and Beleno. • ALBAY particularly Guinale and Upper Donsol. • SORSOGON particularly Lower Donsol, Ogod, Putiao, Cadacan, Banuang-Duan, Fabrica (Tugbugan) and Matnog.

No. 08 (FINAL) for Region VIII (Eastern Visayas)

WATERCOURSES NO LONGER LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • EASTERN SAMAR – particularly Oras, Dolores, Ulot, Taft, Borongan, Suribao, Llorento, Balangiga, and Sulat. • NORTHERN SAMAR - particularly Catarman, Bugko, Pambukhan, Catubig, Palapag, Mano, and Gamay • LEYTE – particularly Sangputan, Palo, Salano (Quilot), Daguitan Marabang, Cadacan, Bongquirogon, Salug, Pagbanagaran, Pagsangahan, and Binahaan • SOUTHERN LEYTE – particularly Bisay, Himbangan, and Pandan • SAMAR – particularly Basey, Silaga, Calbiga, and Jibatan

No. 10 (FINAL) for Region 13 (CARAGA)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light rains and isolated thunderstorms.
WATERCOURSES NO LONGER LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • SURIGAO DEL NORTE particularly Surigao and Magallanes • AGUSAN DEL SUR particularly Ojot, Wawa, Libang, Maosam, Kasilan, Gibong, Adgaoan, Sinulao, Kayonan and Andanan. • DINAGAT ISLANDS particularly Malinao Inlet and Gaas Lulet. • AGUSAN DEL NORTE particularly Lake-Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos and Cabadbaran. • SURIGAO DEL SUR particularly Cantillan, Toracan, Tandag, Tago, Hubo-Oteiza, Hinatuan and Bislig

With this development and unless significant rain occurs, this is the Final General Flood Advisory for this event in Region XIII.

No. 03 for CAR (CORDILLERA ADMINISTRATIVE REGION)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains and isolated thunderstorms
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ABRA particularly Upper Abra, Tineg and Ikmin. • APAYAO particularly Upper Abulug. • BENGUET particularly Upper Bauang.
