AT 4:00 PM TODAY, THE CENTER OF SEVERE TROPICAL STORM "CARINA" WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 30 KM SOUTH OF APARRI, CAGAYAN (18.1°N, 121.6°E) WITH MAXIMUM WINDS UP TO 95 KPH NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 120 KPH. IT IS FORECAST TO MOVE NORTHWEST AT 20 KPH.
