PRESENT WEATHER:

At **3:00 AM** today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at **715 km East of Basco, Batanes (20.9°N, 128.8°E)**. Meanwhile, another LPA was estimated based on all available data at **130 km West Southwest of Iba, Zambales (15.0°N, 118.8°E)**. Southwest Monsoon affecting Central and Southern Luzon and Western Visayas.
