No. 02 for Region III (Central Luzon)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to occasionally moderate rains.
WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • AURORA – particularly Casiguran, Aguang and Lower Umiray.

No. 02 for Region IV-A (CALABARZON)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate with at times heavy rains.
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • QUEZON – particularly Upper Umiray, Lower Bolbok (Lawaya), Malaking-Ilog, Iyam, Macalelon, Catanauan, Silongin Lagda, Pagsanjan, Malaybalay, Maapon, Bucal (Lalangan), Lakayat, Tignoan, Agos, Anibawan (Polilio Island) and Upper Kilbay - Catabangan. • LAGUNA – particularly Pagsanjan, Pila-Sta. Cruz, San Juan and San Cristobal. • RIZAL – particularly Upper Marikina and Kaliwa.

No. 01 for Region IV-B (MIMAROPA)

WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Palawan – Abongan, Lian, Barabakan, Rizal, Caramay, Langogan, Babuyan, Bacungan, Ihawig Penal, Inagauan, Aborlan, Malasgao, Apurauan, Baton-Baton, Aramayawan, Ihawig, Panitian, Pulot, Lamakan, Kinlugaan, Eraan, Tiga Plan, Malabangan, Ilog, Bansang, Conduaga, Culasian, Ihawig (Brookes), Okayan, Canipan and Busuanga, Coron. • Occidental Mindoro – Abra de Ilog, Cagaray, Labangan, Magbando, Lunintao, Anahawin, Monpong, Amnay, Pola, Pagbahan, Mamburao and Ibod • Oriental Mindoro – Malaylay-Baco, Pulang Tubig, Magasawang Tubig, Butas, Pula, Agsalin, Bansud, Samagui, Bongabon, Baroc, Bulalacao and Balete • Marinduque – Tawiran-Tagum (Marinduque) and Boac

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Catanduanes – particularly Cabuyan, Bato and Pajo • Camarines Norte – particularly Labo and Daet Basud • Camarines Sur – particularly Lower Kilbay, Catabangan, Ragay, Tinalmud, Tambang and Lagonoy • Albay – particularly Guinale and Upper Donsol • Masbate – particularly Lanang, Mapayawan, Mandaong, Asid, Malbag, Guiom, Nainday, Daraga, Nauco (Aguada) and Beleno • Sorsogon – particularly Lower Donsol, Ogod, Putiao, Cadacan, Banuang-Duan, Fabrica (Tugbugan) and Matnog

No. 02 for Region VIII (Eastern Visayas)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate with at times heavy rains.
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Northern Samar – particularly Catarman, Bugko, Pambukhan, Catubig, Palapag, Mano and Gamay. • Leyte – particularly Sangputan, Palo, Salano (Quilot), Daguitan Marabang, Cadacan, Bongquirogon, Salug, Pagbanagan, Pagsanghan, and Binahaan. • Southern Leyte – particularly Bisay, Himbangan and Pandan. • Eastern Samar – particularly Oras, Dolores, Ulot, Taft, Borongan, Suribao, Llorento, Balangiga and Sulat. • Samar – particularly Basey, Silaga, Calbiga and Jibatan. • Biliran – all rivers and its tributaries.

No. 02 (Final) for Region IX (Zamboanga Peninsula)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light rains and isolated thunderstorms.
WATERCOURSES NO LONGER TO BE AFFECTED	<p><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Zamboang del Sur - Kamalarang, Tupilac, Labangan and Mapangi. • Zamboanga Sibugay - Tumaga, Taguite, Tigbao, Digma, Sanito, Bakalan, Kabasalan and Sibuguey. • Zamboanga del Norte particularly Paro-Dapitan, Dipolog, Dikaya, Golid Duwait, Sindangan, Ingin (Maras), Palandoc, Bucas, Pataug, Quipit, Siocon, Piacan, Anungan, Pangamiran and Sibuco.
With this development and unless significant rain occurs, this is the final general flood advisory for this event.	

No. 01 for Region XIII (Caraga)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light to moderate rains and thunderstorms.
WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Surigao del Norte – particularly Surigao and Magallanes. • Agusan del Sur – particularly Ojot, Wawa, Libang, Maosam, Kasilan, Gibong, Adgaoan, Sinulao, Kayonan and Andanan. • Dinagat Islands – particularly Malinao Inlet and Gaas Lulet • Agusan del Norte – particularly Lake-Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos, and Cabadbaran. • Surigao del Sur – particularly Cantillan, Toracan, Tandag, Tago, Hubo-Oteiza, Hinatuan, and Bislig.
