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No. 02 for Region XIII (Caraga)

WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Surigao del Norte – particularly Surigao and Magallanes. • Agusan del Sur – particularly Ojot, Wawa, Libang, Maosam, Kasilan, Gibong, Adgaoan, Sinulao, Kayonan and Andanan. • Dinagat Islands – particularly Malinao Inlet and Gaas Lulet • Agusan del Norte – particularly Lake-Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos, and Cabadbaran. • Surigao del Sur – particularly Cantillan, Toracan, Tandag, Tago, Hubo-Oteiza, Hinatuan, and Bislig.
