**PAST 36-HOUR ENDING AT 10:00 AM = 110.5 MM**

**FORECAST 12-HRS STARTING AT 10:00AM TODAY = MODERATE TO HEAVY RAINS**

#### **WATERWAYS TO BE AFFECTED:**

**1. Slow rise of water level in Lake Buhi/Buhi Station**

- **FLOODING HAS OCCURED:** In the low-lying areas of Pob. Buhi

**2. Slow rise of water level in Lake Bato/Bato Station**

- **FLOODING HAS OCCURED:** In the low-lying areas of Bato, Nabua, Libon, Polangui, Oas, Ligao

**3. Slow rise of water level in Ombao, Bicol Region**

- **FLOODING HAS OCCURED:** In the low-lying areas of Ombo, Baao, Bula, Pili

**4. Slow rise of water level in Camaligan, Bicol Region**

- **FLOODING HAS OCCURED:** In the low-lying areas of Camaligan, Bombon, Magarao, Canaman, Naga City, Gainza, Milaor, Minalabac, Pamplona, San Fernando

**5. Slow rise of water level in Balongay, Bicol Region**

- **FLOODING HAS OCCURED:** In the low-lying areas of Calabanga

**6. Slow rise of water level in Sipocot, Sipocot Region**

- **FLOODING HAS OCCURED:** In the low-lying areas of Cabusao, Libmanan, Sipocot
