PRESENT WEATHER:

TAIL-END OF A COLD FRONT AFFECTING MINDANAO AND EASTERN VISAYAS, NORTHEAST MONSOON AFFECTING LUZON.

AVERAGE BASIN RAINFALL:

AS OF 4:30 PM TODAY: **0.0**

PAST 24-HR RAINFALL: **52.36 mm**

FORECAST RAINFALL: **Light to Occasionally Moderate Rains**

WATERCOURSES NO LONGER TO BE AFFECTED:

- Cagayan de Oro River and its Tributaries particularly Bubunauan, Samalauan, Tumalong, Mamala, Batang and Tagite Rivers.

PUBLIC WARNING:

WITH THIS DEVELOPMENT AND UNLESS SIGNIFICANT RAIN OCCURS, THIS IS THE FINAL GENERAL FLOOD ADVISORY FOR THIS EVENT.

HOWEVER, PEOPLE LIVING NEAR THE MOUNTAIN SLOPES AND LOW-LYING AREAS NEAR THE ABOVE MENTIONED RIVERS AND THE LOCAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCILS CONCERNED ARE ADVISED TO TAKE PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES.

You are hereby directed to undertake monitoring of precautionary measures in your AOR. Likewise, the public and DRRMCs concerned are advised to take appropriated actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
