PUBLIC WARNINGS:

Major river channels within the basin are slowly receding. Generally no significant increases in river stages are likely to occur as per present and forecasted weather over the Region. However, residents and Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) who are along the waterways of upstream tributaries within the Pampanga River Basin are still advised to be on alert for any possible minor localized flashfloods and/or river overflowing.
