PRESENT WEATHER:

Northeast Monsoon affecting extreme Northern Luzon.

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	Light rains and isolated thunderstorms
WATERCOURSES NO LONGER TO BE AFFECTED	 Rivers and Tributaries in: ZAMBOANGA DEL SUR particularly Kamalarang, Tupilac, Labangan, and Mapangi. ZAMBOANGA SIBUGAY particularly Tumaga, Taguite, Tigbao, Digsa, Sanito, Bakalan, Kabasalan, and Sibuguey.
With this development and unless significant rain occurs, this is the Final General Flood Advisory for this event.
