PRESENT WEATHER:

At 4:00 AM today, the eye of Typhoon "Falcon" was located based on all available data at 885 km East Northeast Of Itbayat, Batanes (21.8N, 130.3E) with maximum sustained winds of 130 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 160 kph. It is forecast to move west northwest at 20 kph. Southwest Monsoon affecting Luzon and Western Visayas.
