PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 PM today, the eye of Typhoon "KONG-REY" was located based on all available data at 1,395 km East of Central Luzon (16.2°N, 135.2°E) (OUTSIDE PAR) with maximum sustained winds of 160 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 195 km/h.
