Basin Rainfall as of 8:00 AM today:

Past 24-hour Rainfall : less than 5 mm
Forecast 24-hour Rainfall : between 20 to 30 mm

WATER COURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED:

- Tributaries Coronel, Digmala, Penaranda, Talavera, Rio Chico Rivers, and other streams within Nueva Ecija; Upper Main Pampanga River
- Maasim, San Miguel, Bulu, and Angat Rivers (Bulacan)

PUBLIC WARNING:

Generally rivers within the basin are still relatively low; however light to occasionally moderate rains are expected over the eastern sections of the basin beginning late today; residents and Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMC's) adjacent to and/or along the abovementioned waterways are advised to be alert for possible flash floods at the river upstream portions and river overflowing at mid-stream sections; communities near mountain slopes are advised to be alert for possible landslides.
