**PRESENT WEATHER:**

AT 3:00 AM TODAY, THE CENTER OF TROPICAL DEPRESSION "CARINA" WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 315 KM EAST OF TUGUEGARAO CITY, CAGAYAN (17.4°N, 124.8°E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 45 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 55 KM/H. IT IS MOVING WESTWARD AT 20 KM/H.
