<b>WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED</b>	<b><u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Samar</b> – particularly Basey, Silaga, Calbiga and Jibatan</li><li>• <b>Leyte</b> – particularly Sangputan, Palo, Salano (Quilot), Daguitan Marabang, Cadacan, Bongquirogon, Salug, Pagnabagaran, Pagsangahan and Binahaan</li><li>• <b>Southern Leyte</b> – particularly Bisay, Himbangan, and Pandan</li><li>• <b>Eastern Samar</b> – Oras, Dolores, Ulot, Taft, Borongan, Suribao, Llorento, Balangia and Sulat</li><li>• <b>Northern Samar</b> – particularly Catarman, Bugko, Pambukhan, Catubig, Palapag, Mano and Gamay</li></ul>
