PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 PM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 630 KM East of Guiuan, Eastern Samar (10.7N, 131.5E). Southwest Monsoon affecting extreme Northern Luzon. Typhoon JEBI at 3:00 PM Location: 2,775 KM East of Northern Luzon (17.8N, 147.9E) (Outside Par), Maximum Sustained Winds: 160 KM/H, Gustiness: Up to 195 KM/H, Movement: West at 20 KM/H.

FORECAST RAINFALL:

Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers.

WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED:

- **TAGUM-LIBUGANON RIVER** and its tributaries particularly Tuganay, Saug and Lasang Rivers.

PUBLIC WARNINGS:

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low lying areas of the above mentioned river systems and the local disaster risk reduction and management councils (LDRRMCs) concerned are advised to be on alert for possible/further flashfloods and landslides and to take necessary precautionary measures.
