No. 03 for Region VIII (Eastern Visayas)

WATER COURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	<p>Rivers and Tributaries in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Leyte particularly Sangputan, Palo, Salano (Quilot), Daguitan Marabang, Cadacan, Bongquirogon, Salug, Pagbanagaran, Pagsangahan and Binahaan. • Southern Leyte particularly Bisay, Himbangan and Pandan. • Northern Samar particularly Catarman, Bugko, Pambukhan, Catubig, Maou, Gamay. • Samar particularly Basey, Silaga, Calbiga and Jibatan. • Biliran rivers and tributaries. • Eastern Samar particularly Oras, Dolores, Ulot, Taft, Borongan, Suribao, Llorento, Balangiga and Sulat.

People living near the mountains slopes and in the low-lying areas of the above-mentioned river system and the local **Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils** concerned are **advised to take necessary precautionary measures.**
