PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 AM today, the eye of Typhoon “KONG-REY” was located based on all available data at 1,565 km East of Southern Luzon (15.4°N, 136.2°E) (OUTSIDE PAR) with maximum sustained winds of 130 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 160 km/h. It is moving West Northwest at 15 KM/H.
