PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 PM TODAY, THE CENTER OF THE TROPICAL DEPRESSION "AMANG" WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 80 KM NORTHEAST OF HINATUAN, SURIGAO DEL SUR (8.8 N, 16.9 E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 45 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 60 KM/H. MOVING WEST NORTHWEST AT 45 KM/H. NORTHEAST MONSOON AFFECTING LUZON.
