AT 3:00 AM TODAY, THE CENTER OF TROPICAL STORM “KARDING” (YAGI) WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 1,265 KM EAST OF BASCO, BATANES (20.6 °N, 134.1 °E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 65 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 80 KM/H MOVING NORTH NORTHEAST AT 15 KM/H SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING THE WHOLE COUNTRY.
