WATERWAYS TO BE AFFECTED FURTHER:

- **Tributaries of Upper and Middle Agno River**
 - Ambayaoan River
 - Viray-Depalo River
 - Banila and Totonogen Rivers
- **Lower Main Agno River and its Tributaries**
 - Tarlac, Camiling, Olo, Bayaoas Rivers and Tributary Streams
- **Allied Rivers**
 - Sinocalan-Pantal rivers - Tuboy, Tagamusing, Ingalera Rivers and Tributary Streams
 - Cayanga river - Bued, Patalan, Angalacan, Aloragat Rivers and Tributary Streams
