Streams and river tributary of the low-lying areas of Municipality of Libon, Polangui, Oas, Ligao, Bato, Nabua, Baao, Bula, Buhi, Iriga City, Pili, Camaligan, Bombon, Magarao, Canaman, Naga City, Gainza, Milaor, Minalabac, Pamplona, San Fernando, Calabanga, Cabusao, Libmanan, Sipocot.

**PUBLIC WARNING:**

People living near the mountain slopes and low lying areas near the above mentioned rivers and streams are advised to be on alert for possible flashfloods and landslides and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) concerned are advised to be alert and take appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate this through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions - evacuation rather than rescue.
