AVERAGE BASIN RAINFALL AS OF 11:00AM TODAY

PAST 12-HOUR ENDING AT 11:00 AM = 12.8 MM
FORECAST FOR THE NEXT 24-HOUR = MODERATE TO HEAVY RAINS

WATERWAYS TO BE AFFECTED:

- 1. Very slow rise of water level in Lake Buhi/Buhi Station**
 - **URBAN FLOODING IS POSSIBLE:** In the low-lying areas of Pob. Buhi
- 2. Very slow rise of water level in Lake Bato/Bato Station**
 - **URBAN FLOODING IS POSSIBLE:** In the low-lying areas of Bato, Nabua, Libon, Polangui, Oas, Ligao
- 3. Very slow rise of water level in Ombao, Bicol Region**
 - **URBAN FLOODING IS POSSIBLE:** In the low-lying areas of Ombo, Baa, Bula, Pili
- 4. Very slow rise of water level in Camaligan, Bicol Region**
 - **URBAN FLOODING IS POSSIBLE:** In the low-lying areas of Camaligan, Bombon, Magarao, Canaman, Naga City, Gainza, Milaor, Minalabac, Pamplona, San Fernando
- 5. Very slow rise of water level in Balongay, Bicol Region**
 - **URBAN FLOODING IS POSSIBLE:** In the low-lying areas of Calabanga
- 6. Very slow rise of water level in Sipocot, Sipocot Region**
 - **URBAN FLOODING IS POSSIBLE:** In the low-lying areas of Cabusao, Libmanan, Sipocot
