#### **WATER WAYS LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED:**

- **TRIBUTARY RIVERS (PINACANAUAN OF ILAGAN, SAN PABLO AND TUGUEGARAO, GANANO, MAGAT , CHICO, PARED AND DUMMUN RIVER)**

#### **PUBLIC WARNING:**

- **Generally rivers within the basin are still relatively low. However, Northeasterly windflow (Northeast Monsoon) will bring to moderate rains over the basin. Residents and the Local Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMC) adjacent to and or along the above mentioned waterways are advised to be prepared and be alert for flashfloods and rivers overflowing at midstream and downstream areas**

People living near mountain slopes and low lying areas particularly those adjacent to and/along the above mentioned rivers and the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (DRRMCs) concerned are still advised to take necessary appropriate actions.
