AVERAGE BASIN RAINFALL AS OF 4:00PM TODAY

PAST 24-HR OBSERVED RAINFALL = **27 MM**

FORECAST FOR THE NEXT 24-HR = **MODERATE TO OCCASIONALLY HEAVY RAINS**

WATERWAYS TO BE AFFECTED:

- Upper main Cagayan River
- Middle main Cagayan River
- Tributary rivers (Pinacanauan of Ilagan, San Pablo and Tuguegarao, Ganano, Magat, Chico, Pared and Dummun Rivers)

AWARENESS INFORMATION/WARNING:

- Generally, Rivers within the basin are still relatively low; however, **Typhoon "KAREN"** is expected to bring moderate to occasionally heavy rains over the basin. Residents and Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) adjacent to and/or along the above mentioned-waterways are advised to be prepared and alert for possible flashfloods and river overflowing at midstream and downstream areas.
