**PUBLIC WARNING:**

Major river channels within the basin remain relatively low; however, residents and the local Disaster Risk Reduction & Management Councils (DRRMCs) who are near the mountain slopes and along the waterways of upstream tributaries within the Pampanga river basin are still advised to be alert for any possible minor landslides and flashfloods.

Unless no significant developments in the weather condition within the basin occurs, this is the final advisory for the Pampanga river basin.
