Rivers within the basin are still relatively low, however, occasional light to moderate rains are likely to affect the Pampanga River Basin (PRB) starting late tonight or early tomorrow morning.

Residents and LDRRMCs adjacent to and/or along the above-mentioned waterways are advised to prepare and be alert for possible flashfloods and landslides at mountainside areas, further, possible river overflowing of main tributaries.
