PUBLIC WARNING:

Generally rivers within the basin are still low; the southwest monsoon (HABAGAT) rains is expected to continue over the western sections of the Pampanga River Basin (PRB); Residents and Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) adjacent to and / or along the abovementioned waterways are advised to be alert for possible flashfloods at upstream sections and for river overflowing at mid-stream to downstream portions.
